DIVERSITY IN FINANCE WORK STUDY PROGRAM

Since 1990 Central Bank of Boone County has been pleased to offer a diversity work/study program to assist local minority high school graduates in their pursuit of higher education. The objectives of the program are to provide financial assistance to students wishing to attend or currently attending the University of Missouri--Columbia, Stephens College, Columbia College, Moberly Area Community College, William Woods, Westminster or other Mid-Missouri colleges; to provide part-time work to supplement educational opportunities; and to provide income that can enhance the educational process.

CENTRAL BANK OF BOONE COUNTY

- 1. Provide \$1,250.00 per semester, or \$2,500.00 per year, in scholarship funds for recipients. The scholarship/internship is renewable for 4 years, or eight semesters based upon the recipient meeting stated academic and work performance goals.
- Provide the recipient with a part-time PAID job of 15 to 20 hours per week during the academic year with the possibility of additional hours per week during the summer recess.
- **3.** Work with the recipient to ensure an adequate work experience and academic progress.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Maintain satisfactory college academic progress and a grade point of average of 2.5 enrolled in college to retain the scholarship.

2. Work a minimum of 15 hours per week at Central Bank of Boone County and maintain a commendable or above performance record while employed by the bank.

3. Be open-minded upon initial receipt of the scholarship as to employment upon college graduation with Central Bank of Boone County or within the Central Bancompany organization.
